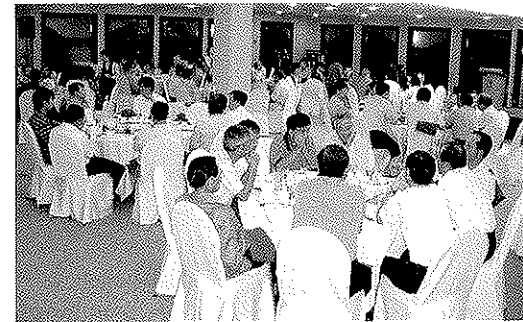
Prizes were also awarded to the top 28 to 35 players in the various divisions. In
