The CMS Awards were presented to recipients at the ASMI's 43rd anniversary dinner held on 28 October. The prestigious annual award gives recognition to outstanding supervisors in the marine industry.

The CMS Award Scheme, first introduced in 1998, encourages upgrading of supervisory personnel. To qualify for the award, candidates must meet a set of requirements which include completion of training in safety management, marine

supervision and project management. They must also be role models with positive work attitude, strong leadership capabilities and excellent job performance.

To date, 391 marine supervisory personnel have received the awards. The CMS awards are approved by the CMS Board, comprising representatives from both industry and tertiary organisations.
