

17TH ASMI 7-A-SIDE SOCCER TOURNAMENT

The 17th ASMI 7-A-Side Soccer Tournament 2012 was held on 22 April at Ngee Ann Polytechnic's Soccer Field. The full-day event started bright and early in the morning. Players and their supporters started streaming into the stadium from 7.30am to prepare for the first match which commenced at 8.00am.

The Preliminary round of the tournament was played in round-robin format and with the 20 teams placed into four groups. The Preliminary round was played throughout the morning and into the early afternoon. The teams, well decked out in full soccer gear, warmed up at the sidelines whilst awaiting their turns to enter the soccer field for their respective matches. The top two teams from each group advanced into the quarter finals played based on knockout

format. The winner of each match met at the semi-finals and then the finals.
