ASMI started the presentation with an overview of the industry, followed by information on the two ASMI scholarships available to MOT students. These are the ASMI Scholarship and ASMI-Marine and Offshore Technology Scholarship. The scholarships are sponsored by DDW-PaxOcean Shipyard, Keppel Offshore and Marine, Sembcorp Marine and Singapore Technologies Marine.

The ASMI Scholarship is targeted at students enrolled in diploma courses in MOT, mechanical engineering, electrical engineering and mechatronics engineering. It is valued at \$\$5,000 per annum and comes with one year of bond for each year of award. Some 455 ASMI Scholarships have been presented to students in both Ngee Ann Polytechnic and Singapore Polytechnic to date.

The ASMI-MOT Scholarship is targeted at first year students enrolled in MOT

course. This scholarship is valued at \$\$10,000 per annum and comes with a three-year bond. A total of 77 ASMI-MOT Scholarships have been awarded to date.

ASMI SCHOLARSHIP SCHEMES

ASMI has been offering scholarships collectively as an industry since 1987 to attract young talents to join the marine and offshore industry. The ASMI Scholarship scheme, which started with then School of Engineering in Ngee Ann Polytechnic, had since been expanded to accept students taking the marine engineering and other relevant engineering courses in postsecondary and tertiary institutions such as the Institute of Technical Education, Singapore Polytechnic, Nanyang Technological University, Newcastle University (UK) and Singapore Institute of Technology.

Currently, there are a total of eight scholarship schemes available at the technical certificate, diploma and degree levels. The scholarship awards are valued between \$\$5,000 per annum to \$49,250 per annum. The scholarships come with a one to three-year bond with the sponsoring companies.

Scholarship recipients are required to meet a set of stringent selection criteria including good academic results and cocurricular activities as well as leadership potential. They are required to serve a bond upon graduation and completion of National Service (if applicable) with their respective sponsors.

The ASMI Scholarship Schemes have benefitted some 823 individuals since 1987. Many of them are still serving in the industry today.

The main sponsors for the ASMI Scholarships these past years are the three major shipyard groups - Keppel Offshore and Marine, Sembcorp Marine and Singapore Technologies Marine. DDW-PaxOcean Shipyard has also come onboard as sponsor for some of these scholarships.
